Example1

You can see some striking differences in the population compositions between Saga prefecture and Tokyo metropolis. In Saga, there are more elderly people than young, and especially fewer young people from 20 to 29 years old. This is probably because they go out to big cities to study or work, never to return. In Tokyo, the largest age groups are between 25 to 59 of age. This means that Tokyo is a big business city and attracts a large workforce from all over Japan. However, the rates of young people under 19 in the population here are remarkably low. Tokyo is also an aging city. (104 words)

Example2

The two graphs show that both Saga and Tokyo have more female than male population. It should also be noted that the number of those in their forties is relatively high. In fact, those in these age groups comprise the largest portion of the population in Tokyo. Most importantly, the graphs confirm the popular perception that Japan is a super-aging society with a declining birth rate. This trend is obvious when you compare the population of the elderly with that of young people. Especially in Saga, the number of people in their sixties is larger than that of any other age group. Example1

If this tendency continues, both Saga prefecture and Tokyo metropolis will suffer from the problem of aging society. As the number of working people decreases, the local governments will collect less tax money. In addition, as the number of elderly people increases, health care costs will double or even triple. This is an inevitable negative spiral caused by the dynamic trends in population. (63 words)

Example2

Japanese society will be much older. Because of this aging trend, Saga and Tokyo could also see their workforce decrease, while social security cost would increase. In addition, both regions might need to provide social welfare service to many of those who are now in their forties as they had difficulty finding secure jobs when they were younger. (58 words)
